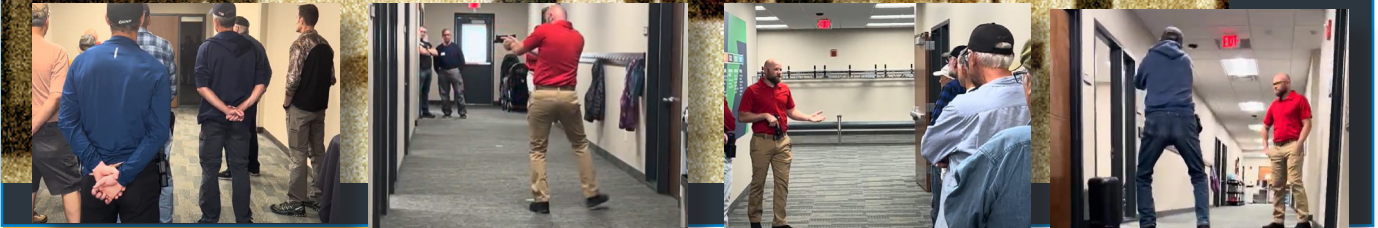


REALITY-BASED TRAINING

ARMED CHURCH SECURITY TEAMS



IS YOUR ARMED CHURCH SECURITY TEAM PROPERLY TRAINED?

This reality-based training program is a four-hour introduction for armed church security teams striving to improve their ability to handle lethal threats effectively.

The objective of this program is to begin the process of training team members to safely and effectively deal with a lethal force confrontation.

With this program you will learn how to:

- Move safely and effectively.
- Use basic compliance commands and radio protocols for communicating lethal threats.
- Maneuver through various hallways - "L" hallway, "T" intersections with a loaded weapon.
- Pie a door opening, enter, and clear a room.
- Engage and eliminate a lethal threat.
- Operate effectively under fire.

This program is conducted at the contracting church site using Airsoft non-lethal munitions.

The scenarios are tailored to your church's security challenges.

The program will accommodate up to 10 students and includes access to Kingdom Defense online content.

Reality-based training uses Airsoft non-lethal weapons to simulate lethal force confrontations. The scenarios are created for each Church depending upon their specific security objectives.




TRAINING IS THE SUM OF INSTRUCTION PLUS PRACTICE

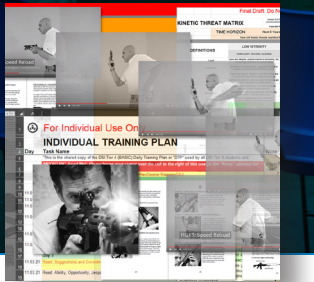
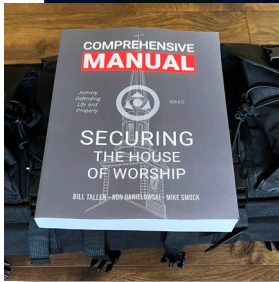

TRAINING

We see many examples of informal approaches taken to develop armed church security teams. While we certainly commend the initiative behind this effort, we also caution those deploying this approach. The reason for the caution is that most of the time we see teams that have not been properly trained and are ill-prepared to deal with a lethal force confrontation. Developing an armed church security team requires:

- A full range of gun handling and tactical skills.
- Training that correctly instructs and provides sufficient repetition to establish habits.
- Teaching situational awareness and decision making through stressful reality-based training.

Developing these capabilities requires experienced instructors and a comprehensive curriculum. In addition to this introductory program, Kingdom Defense offers several comprehensive training programs and schools including its "Team Leader School" for church security team leaders. WHO IS THIS PROGRAM FOR?

This program is for serving church security team members and is offered for teams only. Participants do not need to be law enforcement or military but do need basic firearms training and must pass a security background check. All participants must be in good physical shape able to move and withstand high-stress situations.

Kingdom Defense integrates firearm fundamentals, individual tactics, team tactics, tactical medical, and tactical communications with reality-based training that is delivered on range, on-site, and online via a comprehensive training plan that coordinates daily, weekly, monthly, and annual tasks, activities, and events.

PROGRAM COST

The 4-hour program cost is \$750 for up to 10 participants. The cost includes:

- Turnkey 4-hour program.
- Supporting video and text resources.
- Post program training plan.
- Copy of "Comprehensive Manual - Securing the House of Worship".

The program is conducted on-site at the contracting church and the scenarios are adapted to fit the security challenges of that organization.

The cost does not include travel expenses or production supplies which will be invoiced separately.
